Who/What is Pray America



- Orphanage
 - Early years: built up Casa Bernabe, Guatemala City
- Feeding Programs
 - 1200 kids fed twice a week
 - \$15 feeds a child twice a wk
 - Xepocol (“SHEP-o-call”)
 - Patzibal (“POTS-ee-bol”)
 - Saquilla (“SA-key-a”)
- Widows Housing
 - Over 400 houses built
 - Bible Studies
- House of Prayer / Manos de Jesus
 - Mission House, Chichi

- 30 Cooks, 20 Teachers, 12 Support Staff in Chichi
- Ron Morin, President and Executive Director

Feeding Programs

- Feed 1200 + kids per week
- Three locations
 - 2 with Kitchens and Comidors (covered eating area)
 - \$15 per month feeds a child twice a week
- Nutrition supplement
- Clean water to local kids and families (2 out of 3 locations)
- Bible teaching and worship time
- Teams have brought clothes, t-shirts, shoes, soccer balls

Feeding Programs



Widow Houses

- Over 70,000 widows in the Chichi area (size of a large US county)
- Over 400 widow houses built
- \$1300 builds a house for a widow with cement floor
- Women Bible studies, 200+ meals weekly
- Teams have brought: reading glasses for weaving, sweaters, shoes and t-shirts.

Widows Houses



Jesus de Manos – House of Prayer

- Pray America's Mission Home in Chichi
- Clean, comfortable beds and showers
 - Washer/dryer, American Outlets
- Garden sitting area for conversation and meditation
- Teams gather around the large fireplace to relax at the day's end
- Safe and delicious meals for Americans – plenty of clean water

Mission Teams

- Great “mission 101” experience
- Comfortable for the experienced missionary
- Not “too far” from home
- Intimate mission teams for personal and team growth (15 person ideal)
- \$700 + airfare
(includes all meals, transportation, 7-nights accommodation & trip insurance)
- \$1300 builds a widow house

Mission Trip – At a Glance

- **Typical Itinerary** (subject to vary)
 - Day 1: Fly into Guatemala City – Bus up to Chichi
 - Day 2: Build widow house/ feeding program
 - Day 3: Sunday Worship – Market Day shopping
 - Day 4: Build widow house
 - Day 5: Build widow house / feeding program
 - Day 6: Sightseeing trip
 - Day 7: Market Day – feeding program
 - Day 8: Bus back to Guatemala City – fly home
